If you would like your child to join an after-school club, we need to compile a register so that we know which children are expected to remain on the school premises. Please email the school office with the name of your child and the club they wish to join.

If a club is oversubscribed, we will let you know, and your child will be kept on a waiting list.

### Attendance

From August 2024, the Government introduced new rules which are intended to reduce unauthorised absences in schools and thereby improve school attendance.

Head teachers can continue to use discretion to authorise absences in 'exceptional circumstances' but all holidays or leisure time (for whatever reason) may not be authorised by head teachers.

*"Generally, the DfE does not consider a need or desire for a holiday or other absence for the purpose of leisure and recreation to be an exceptional circumstance."*

All Local Authority schools will be obliged to issue a fine when a pupil misses 10 or more school sessions (for unauthorised reasons). A session counts as either a morning or an afternoon session therefore 10 missed sessions is equivalent to 5 full school days missed. The 10 or more unauthorised sessions must be within a 10-week rolling period. The fine amount is increasing to £160 if paid within 28 days, reduced to £80 when paid within 21 days. There is an introduction of a flat rate of £160 for a second penalty notice within a three-year period and not allowing more than 2 penalty notices, after which an alternative route (e.g. prosecution) will be considered instead as the penalty is clearly not working.

For other absences including hospital appointments and sickness, please contact the school office by **9:30am at the latest** so that your child's absence can be recorded accurately. **We will follow up unexplained absences daily and may need to conduct a home visit if we are unable to contact anyone who can confirm the absence.** Please note that parents choosing to keep their children at home will have the absence recorded as unauthorised.

For further guidance please see the attendance policy which is available on the school's website.

### **Uniform**

It is expected that all children wear school uniform including black shoes. If your child cannot wear the school uniform for religious, medical or health reasons, please let us know in writing so that we can make a record in your child's file. Please note that your child will not be able to participate in PE lessons, including swimming, if they are wearing any jewellery. If your child wears ear studs and cannot remove them themselves, please send them to school without them. Taping over ear studs is not acceptable.

Equipment check list: (please do not bring anything not on the checklist) Please do not put juice or flavoured water into water bottles. **Only water is allowed in classrooms. Children may bring juice in a lunch box which is kept in their locker and can be consumed at lunchtime with their meal.**

- Coat with hood
- PE kit with indoor and outdoor clothing, socks and trainers (to be in school on a Monday and remain in school for the week)
- Lunchbox (with juice drink inside the box) ordered lunches will be distributed to children daily
- Water bottle for the desk containing water only
- Children should **NOT** bring in equipment from home such as pencil cases etc
- Children in Reception to year 2 are provided a fruit snack at breaktime. For children in years 3-6 and those wanting to provide their own snack please ensure this is a healthy fruit snack. Crisps, biscuits and chocolate bars are not allowed.

### **Reading, House points and the School Library**

This year we continue with our house point system to encourage good learning behaviour using our school values and an extra guaranteed house point may be earned if your child has at least 4 signatures per week from their parent / guardian to confirm they have read at home or had a book read to them.

Children will continue to have access to reading books and there will be increased opportunities for reading in class.

We will continue to encourage more reading at home with the presentation of a small prize to each child who gains 10 house points in their reading record book. Reading is a gateway to learning. Please encourage your child to read their reading books at home or they may prefer to read other reading material you already have at home or to have a book read to them. All this is valuable for your child in helping them to read and enjoy reading.

**Please sign your child's reading record book each time they read with you or if you read to them.**

**4 signatures per week = 1 house point**

**10 house points for reading = prize**

### **Our School Values**

This year we continue our scheme of work for the Personal, Social and Health Education part of the curriculum. Each term a different 'habit' or value will be introduced to the children with the aim that they adopt these values as a lifestyle choice and become the confident leaders of tomorrow. This is an aspirational and fun scheme, which parents can join in with at home if they wish. Any child displaying behaviour associated with one of the values may also be eligible for a house point! The values are listed below and this term we will be looking at habit one and three.

In addition we are promoting our federation vision of 'With God Together We Can.....' emphasising to children that more can be achieved, better supported and learned when we do things together. Children may display success in working together by sporting one of our stickers.

## Parking

Many of you arrive at school in a car and I realise that you would like to park as close to the school as possible. Please park legally and courteously. Please note that it is illegal to park on a road junction or on, or opposite yellow zigzag lines. Please do not obstruct residents' right of access to and from their property or use their driveways to turn. Please be aware when parking that the school bus requires access to Church Street. Please help us to keep our children safe.

**To the Parents and Guardians of Harlaxton Primary School,**

**Subject: Important Notice – Please Do Not Use Harlaxton Surgery Car Park**

We are writing to you as the team at Harlaxton Surgery with a serious concern regarding the continued unauthorised use of our car park by parents during school drop-off and pick-up times.

Unfortunately, we have seen a growing number of parents using our car park to drop off or collect children from Harlaxton Primary School, or as a turning circle. This behaviour is creating multiple problems:

- **Risk to Elderly and Vulnerable Patients:** Many of our patients have mobility difficulties, are elderly, or are otherwise vulnerable. The additional traffic during peak school times presents a real safety hazard.
- **Damage to Property:** Improper use of the car park has already caused hundreds of pounds' worth of damage. This includes damage to kerbs, signage, and vehicles.
- **Impact on Patient Services:** Continued misuse of the car park may lead to increased maintenance costs, which could have a financial impact on the services we are able to provide to our patients.

Please note that the car park is for **surgery patients only**. We must ask all parents to refrain from using it for any reason unless you are attending a medical appointment.

We appreciate the pressures of the school run, but we ask for your full cooperation to ensure the safety and well-being of our patients and staff, and to help us protect the resources we need to deliver care.
