Grammar and Spelling:

In grammar we will be learning: Y5- parenthesis, expanded noun phrase and tenses; Y6-hyphens, semi-colons, colons, active and passive voice, and the use of formal and informal. Our spellings will be based on the Read Write Inc spelling programme and the children will bring home weekly spellings.

Talk for Writing:

This term we will write a poem based on volcanoes, a persuasive rescue letter, a balanced argument 'Should People Live Near Volcanoes?' and film and produce a news broadcast about the eruption of Vesuvius in AD79. The children will critique, edit and revise their work to ensure that it is suitable for the audience.

Reading:

We will continue our whole class reading comprehension, focusing on inference, deduction, word choice and meaning, prediction, comparison, summarising and retrieval. We will focus on oracy.

Maths

We will focus on developing our mastery understanding of:

- Multiplication
- Division
- Decimals and percentages
- Fractions,
- Area and perimeter
- Statistics

Computing

We will evaluate and apply information technology, using the internet effectively to provide data in news report. We will use a range of digital devices to design & create our news broadcast linked to our project work. We will also look at e-safety and the importance of staying safe online.

Science

We will investigate properties and changes of materials. We will compare & group together everyday materials based on their properties, giving reasons based on evidence.

PSHE

This term we will focus on living in the wider world. We will be learning about prejudice, discrimination and inclusion and our rights. We will also learn about digital media and altered images as well as money and finance. We will also participate in a positive relationships workshop led by Positive Health.
