PE

We will master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching and participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending. PE day is Friday, but please have kit in all week!

Geography

We will use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) to help us with our field work looking at our local area whilst studying human and physical features when viewing maps.

Maths

In Maths, we will be;

- Learning to count to 100 through different steps including counting up in 10s, 2s and 5s. Year 2 will also develop their place value knowledge and compare numbers. We will also explore numbers to see patterns within 100.
- Explore addition and subtraction using number bonds, representing this using manipulatives (concrete resources), diagrams and written methods.

Science

We will begin and finish the term observing seasonal change, looking at the changes that Autumn brings. This will support us in investigating classification of trees and plants. Especially looking at deciduous and evergreen trees found in our local area.

Computing

This term we will understand what algorithms are and how they are implemented through coding sessions. We will create and debug simple programs. Purple Mash Logins are in Reading Records and Homework books.

Art

We will investigate and create art in the style of Andy Goldsworthy, looking at natural art including sculptures.

Religious Education

We will explore what Christians and Muslims beliefs are and how these are expressed whilst learning about celebrations that are important in both these religions and what are the key practises associated with these celebrations.

Music

We will learn to play tuned and untuned instruments, inventing rhythms and begin to read graphic notations.

Dear parents,

Welcome to Year 2. We have a great term planned, investigating the woods and local area and hope to get outside as much as we can. I hope your child is excited and ready for Year 2, I know myself and the team are very eager to get the term underway. Below are some housekeeping items and information of our week, if you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to either speak to one of us at the door on drop off/pick up or send an email to the office.

- **School start and end** – In Year 2, the teacher will collect the children from the front (red) doors at 8.45am and at the end of the day, they will be collected at the same location at 3.25pm.
- **Water bottles** – A bottle should be brought into school every-day and should only contain water; these can be placed on the children's tables. If children prefer juice, this will stay in their locker for lunch time.
- **Snacks** – We provide a range of fruit and vegetables daily which the children have access too at break time. If you would prefer to send in your own healthy snack, please ensure this is not chocolate or crisps and nut free.
- **Lunch** – Children will sit together whether having packed lunches or hot dinners. Children are eligible for 'Universal Free School Meals' from Reception to Year 2. This can be ordered via Ideal School Meals. This can be a mix of hot dinners alongside planned packed lunches too.
- **Reading books** – We will aim to change books on a **Monday** this term. Please record each time your child has read their school book in their reading record. If your child reads more than four times in a week, they will gain a bonus house point. For every ten reading house points, the children will receive a small prize from Mrs Edwards!
- **Spellings and Homework** – This term homework will come home on a **Tuesday**, to be handed in the following **Monday**. Spelling tests follow the spelling pattern taught the previous week, these will be on **Mondays**. Your child has a grid of the spellings for the term, this can also be found on the class website.
- **Library Books** – On a **Friday**, children will choose a book from the class library to take home and share. This book is for you to share together and swap the following **Friday**.
- **Logins** for the different platforms are in the front of your child's homework book and reading records – these include 'NumBots/Times Tables Rock Stars' and 'Purple Mash'. If you need help accessing these, please let a member of our team know.
- **PE** – We aim to complete PE on a **Friday** this term, please ensure PE kits are in school all week should this change. Sessions will happen both inside and outside (weather permitting), so please send your child in with appropriate clothing - joggers and a hoodie alongside their usual PE kit. Please name all uniform and PE kit so we can return lost items. Anything unnamed will be placed in lost property.
- **School website** -There will be a variety of content uploaded each week, with pictures of children's work as well as photos to share our achievements, so please keep an eye out.
